Prof. Eliseyeva's previous positions include the Head of the Department of Hypertension, the Republican Center of Cardiology (2003-2011); Head of pharmacological screening for the Joint Project of Central Asia ICBG (International Cooperative Biodiversity Groups: Rutgers, the State University, New Jersey, US, and Republican Center of Cardiology, Tashkent, Uzbekistan) (2003-2007); Expert on cardiovascular diseases of the Expert Council, the Higher Attestation Commission at the Cabinet of Ministers of Uzbekistan (1998-2005); Professor of the Faculty of General Practice at the 1st Tashkent State Medical Institute (1996-1999). Prof. Eliseyeva has served as managing editor of the Journal "Cardiology of Uzbekistan" (2006-2010).

Prof. Eliseyeva has more than 200 scientific publications, including 3 monographs. She was a research supervisor of 16 PhD dissertations. She has been involved in developing educational and preventive programs to prevent cardiovascular diseases. She is the editor of 5 monographs published by IMRDC. Prof. Eliseyeva has presented thematic papers at international cardiology conferences in Europe and the USA.

Prof. Eliseyeva is a member of the American Society of Hypertension, the European Society of Cardiology, the American Heart Association, the American Stroke Association, and the Uzbek National Association of Cardiologists.
